But makes this chair so incredible rare are the arm terminals carved as perfectly proportioned human hands holding a twisted vasiform arm support. In all honesty I am guessing at the country of origin. There is a blending of French Provincial and English form and style. Thus my possible Canadian origin theory. Retains its original dry finish. Now upholstered in period 18th Century Crewel Bed Hangings.
